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The Parables are short imaginary stories which Jesus told the people to teach them about God and the way to heaven.


THE GREAT FEAST

NCE there was a sower who went out and sowed seed. Some seeds fell by the side of the road, and the birds came and ate them up.


Other seeds fell upon rocky ground. When they began to grow they did not have enough soil and quickly died.
