



That is what we mean by saying that He is the *Judge* of the living and of the dead.


We are in this world to know God, to serve Him and to love Him, so that we may be happy with Him in the life to come.


THE MEANING OF LIFE

CHAPTER TWENTY-FIRST

BENEDICTION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT

My dear Child:

What does Benediction mean? It means that Our Lord blesses us. He is brought forth from the Tabernacle and then placed high upon the Altar.

Many candles are lighted. Incense is burned. Flowers are placed around His Throne.

We try to show Him that He is our King; we draw near to Him and sing His praises; we tell Him of our dangers and we ask Him to protect us; we ask Him to bless

us and to bring us at last to His home in heaven.

A good Catholic child should love to assist at Benediction.

The little children who lived in our Lord's time drew near to Him and He laid His hands upon them and blessed them. He will do the same for you at Benediction.

Da robur, fer auxílium.


Thine aid supply, Thy strength
